Membership for 2022: To date we have 132 members.

Capital Improvements Budget Request for 2023. A copy of the Budget request for 2023 is attached. This Budget attempted to identify and budget for items that should have been updated, replaced and/or renovated. While it is doubtful that the budget will be approved as submitted, it will provide a working list of the multitude of items that fall into this category.

Reforestation Program: We are planning on planting 10 – 15 trees and bushes in October as our first step in the LHCC reforestation Program. For this year we have \$2,000.00 budget for the purchase and planting of the initial trees and bushes. The replanting will enhance the beauty of the golf course and provide some level of protection from errant golf balls.
